Leah Desjardins Bonneau Brendan's mother (died 1865)

Charles Bonneau Brendan's father (died 1864)

Sarah Bonneau Brendan's maiden aunt from Wilmington.

Louis Charles Bonneau older brother of Lilién and Brendan, died 1859

Gabriel Bonneau Former slave and nephew of Charles Bonneau. Married to Jenny.

Jenny Bonneau Former slave. Married to Gabriel.

Edgar & Hannah Hall Neighbors, at Laurelton plantation.

Wilson Hall Best friend of Brendan and Lilién's fiancé

Amelia Hall Sister of Wilson Hall

Delphine Cook and housekeeper at Laurelton, daughter is Muriel
